

BITTER-ROOT JUDGMENT AND EXPECTANCY

SCRIPTURES

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, this he will also reap. Gal. 6:7

Do not judge lest you be judged yourselves. For in the way you judge, you will be judged; and by your standard of measure, it shall be measured to you. Matt. 7: 1-2

See to it that no one comes short of the grace of God; that no root of bitterness springing up causes trouble, and by it many are defiled. Heb. 12: 15

Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, so that you may live long and that it may go well with you in the land the Lord your God is giving you. Deut. 5:16

Do not judge and you will not be judged. Do not condemn and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven. Give and it will be given to you. PRAYER FOR RELEASE OF BITTER ROOT JUDGMENT & EXPECTANCY

Dear Heavenly Father: In the Name of Jesus, I repent for the sin of judging Your creation. I have judged and condemned others although I am not a righteous judge, and have no right to judge anyone. Jesus committed no sin, and was righteous, but He judged no one. Jesus entrusted Himself to You, the One who judges righteously. So I now entrust myself to You.

Please forgive me for this sin of judging others and condemning others. I now bless those who I have judged. I bless those I have accused. I bless those who hate me and have cursed me. I break the power of the spiritual law of sowing and reaping.

I ask You to bless them and give them what they need.

I now intend to sow blessings into my life by blessing those people who have spitefully used me, in Jesus's Name. Thank You, Lord, for forgiving me and helping me to forgive others.

PROCEDURE

If you are experiencing consequences and “reaping” in your life that does not line up with the wonderful promises of God as found in the Bible, ask the Holy Spirit to reveal the root or source of your problems. We as spiritual people need to look back and find out what we may have “sown”, that is what we may have done, that has caused a harvest of problems, e.g. health problems, poverty, marriage issues, and misery in our lives.

You should try to recognize the original event. Ask for forgiveness for judging another person, even if you do not recall judging, when your “reaping” indicates that you did judge and are now “reaping” the consequences. Persons most likely judged are parents and family members.

We must forgive. Forgiving someone does not mean we approve of what they did. It means we give them to God.

We can discern if something is good or bad, right or wrong, and still not judge.
